The South Suburban College Paramedic Program trains men and women for positions as Emergency Medical Technicians in various settings including ambulance services, fire departments and volunteer emergency care services. Students wishing to be considered for admission to the Paramedic Program must contact one of the approved agencies affiliated with South Cook County EMS Systems at Ingalls Memorial Hospital in Harvey IL for additional information and referral.



To qualify for referral, students must:

1. Be at least 18 years of age.
2. Be a graduate from an approved high school or have earned a General Education Development (GED) certificate.
3. Possess an EMT-B Illinois license.
4. Have at least six months work experience.

### **Paramedic Curriculum**

The prerequisite for the program is EMT 215 – Emergency Medical Training, a six credit-hour course. The following schedule is the minimum requirement to earn the Paramedic Certificate.
