# Forensic Science Technology Curriculum

This new and exciting Career Education Program at South Suburban College prepares students for entry level positions within crime laboratories. The curriculum includes theoretical and technical instruction. It is designed to expose students to a broad subject matter of anthropology, psychology, pathology, forensic laboratory technology, crime scene analysis, fingerprint technology, document analysis, pattern analysis, examination procedures, applicable law and regulations, and professional standards and ethics.



## Program Requirements:

1. Submit an Admissions Application and forward all high school as well as other college transcripts directly to the Office of Admissions and Registration.
2. Submit a Forensic Science Technology Application to the Department by mail or in person at Room 4453.
3. Students will be considered for Admissions who have received at least a grade of "C" or better in all program prerequisites and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better. All final course grades will be validated prior to the start of the program.
