A variety of scholarships now available at South Suburban College

SOUTH HOLLAND, IL – The South Suburban College Foundation (SSCF) recently completed their 2008 Donor Drive, raising over \$70,000 in scholarship donations for SSC students. Now, the 2009 Scholarship Books and Applications are available in the Foundation Office and online at www.SouthSuburbanCollege.edu. The primary deadline for applications is March 27, 2009, while graduating high school students can continue to apply for Foundation High School Scholarships throughout the spring and summer.

A wide-range of scholarships are available for incoming high school students, current SSC students, and returning adults. The majority of scholarships are awarded annually in May for the following summer, fall, and spring semesters, while high school scholarships are awarded year-round. In addition to scholarships, SSC offers a variety of tuition waivers including those for returning adults and high school students.

Local high school students can get a head start on their college education through the High School Tuition Waiver. High school seniors who live in or attend a high school in South Suburban College District #510 have the opportunity to take a “tuition free” course at SSC during their senior year, or during the summer before or after.
